Preventative Maintenance Schedule (Brian's responsibility)

- DAILY Maintain the pool, equipment deck and furniture. Uncover pool (limited to winter months), maintain restrooms, maintain water fountain and shower area, empty trash receptacles at pool, check all exterior lighting and maintain as necessary, police grounds and parking lots for large deadfall and trash.
- WEEKLY Keep buildings and light fixtures at doors free of cobwebs and dirt, keep walkways and stairwells blown clean, treat for ants and remove wasp nests as discovered, fill in animal holes as discovered.
- MONTHLY Wipe down windowsills with damp cloth, wipe down handrails on walkways and stairwells, check all battery backup emergency lighting.
- QUARTERLY Pressure wash all sidewalks, walkways and stairwells.
- ANNUALLY Manually turn off water valves to ensure they are operable.
- AS NEEDED Troubleshoot and repair minor electrical and plumbing problems, make wood repairs when necessary and feasible, touch up paint where needed, check windowsills for cracks and repair, keep maintenance room inventory with routine supplies for maintenance, pool and restrooms, maintain a calendar with dates and amounts of supplies purchased.
- Any other activities as directed by the Board or AmeriTech on an 'AS NEEDED' basis.
